Consent Form

I hereby give permission to the medical personnel selected by the camp director to order X-Rays, routine test, treatment: to release any record as necessary for insurance purposes and to provide necessary related transportation for my child, dog or me. Nearest hospital is Thomas Hospital. Nearest Veterinary care is Baldwin Animal Clinic. In the event I cannot be reached in case of an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician/veterinarian selected by the camp director to secure and administer treatment, including hospitalization, for my child or vet care for my dog. I understand that no accident or medical insurance is provided with this activity.

I give consent for my child to leave the campsite/training center, participate in authorized trips, and to ride in authorized vehicles, boats, canoe and kayaks for the purpose of transportation in connection with Grand Hotel Fish Camp. It is further agreed that Grand Hotel Fish Camp assumes no responsibility for the loss of camper's personal property.

WHAT THE CAMPER WILL LEARN

After growing up at the old Grand Hotel Fishing Lodge as a child, my Dad started BelleShain Kennels on the property in 1958. Dad actively raised not only my brother, sister, and I, but also many of his friends' children and their friends and their dogs. There were many adventures and much history with dogs, primarily retrievers back then. There were many awards on a national level. Dad has passed on and I have continued that tradition and history through our Train the Trainer program at BelleShain Kennels for the past several years. Dog owners/parents meet me here during the week at their schedule to receive training instruction and guidance on all things DOG. Often there will be several dog owners at the same time. We encourage family fun here and have many options to do just that including Adventures & Excursions, outdoor sports, river adventures, canoe and kayak, private dog park and WoofBar!

The adventures continued and it was some of these friends that talked me into hosting the summer camp sessions. We have a great time here and life is truly an adventure in learning.

In working and playing with their dogs, Our campers will learn a few life lessons:

- Working as a Team
- Self Discipline
- Patience & Coolness under pressure
- Integrity
- Communication Skills
- Failure and Success
- Perseverance

You might ask about the failure and success. Dogs fail us all the time and we often fail our dogs. We might train for a specific result, get good results and when it comes time to show them off, the performance is not what was expected. We do not have the win that we expected. We have to learn that we, as a team with our dog, were not quite ready. We must go back and do our homework better. We must learn how to communicate better with our dog. We learn to fail gracefully. We learn to win gracefully and to be humble when we win because we understand how hard the homework is. Campers will have wins and losses each day and they will learn that with hard work they will have more wins. It is not difficult. It just takes practice! Some dogs will need more practice than others. You cannot have a win without a loss first and you must have fun along the way!

ACTIVITIES

The main activity will be the obedience dog training with the kayaking & swimming.

Individual specialty training for your dog, (dock diving, hunt test, agility, Frisbee, or perhaps more obedience), tubing, fishing, advanced paddling skills, and/or archery.

If we get some rainy weather; that could create opportunities for other activities:

Dogs will be trained according to AKC Canine Good Citizen Guidelines

We will keep an active schedule that can be tiring for some campers. The only down time will be at lunch break or a snack break. Because of this we offer a shorter day.

Rules, Policies, Cancellation, & Payment 2021

Campers and their dogs should be healthy, polite, and respectful of all camp personnel and fellow campers.

Medications need to be disclosed to Camp Director at least 5 days prior to attendance

Training and Activities shall be at the direction of the Camp Director.

All campers will need to pass a swim test on first day. They should be confident swimmers.

Life Jackets shall be required for all watersports activities at ALL times.

Campers shall be responsible for controlling their dog at all times.

Campers and Dogs will be assessed in their abilities on the first day for recommended activities.

Aggressive dogs can and will be sent home. NO REFUNDS. Camper can be assigned another dog.

Campers who for whatever reason are disruptive and disrespectful shall be sent home. NO REFUNDS. Dog can stay and continue training.

Cell Phones are not allowed during training or activities. They shall be made available in the office if needed.

Waterproof cameras are allowed. Camp Director shall also provide some photos each day. We will post to Facebook, Instagram, and Youtube.

All deposits are NON REFUNDABLE

FINAL PAYMENT is required PRIOR TO ATTENDANCE and NON REFUNDABLE.

If valid reason for non attendance is presented the camper may be rescheduled for another session as availability permits.

Campers are assigned sessions as directed by the Camp Director. Special requests should be requested at least 60 days in advance and are NOT guaranteed for fulfillment.

SPACE IS LIMITED to 6 campers per week at the discretion of the Camp Director.
